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Minutes of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Nagaland State GST Co-ordination Committee for 2024-25 held on 27.11.2024.

2. The 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Nagaland State Co-ordination Committee for 2024-25 was held through VC on 27.11.2024. The meeting was co-chaired by Dr. Shailendra Kumar Sinha, Chief Commissioner of CGST Guwahati Zone. Shri Y. Mhathung Murry, Special Commissioner of State Taxes, Nagaland represented the Commissioner of State Taxes, Nagaland, who is also the co-chair to the Committee. Following other Members of the Committee also attended the meeting.

3. To begin with, the Chief Commissioner welcomed all the participants present in the meeting. He asked whether any space was allotted by the railway for the Central/State GST Department to install check post as per para-9 of Freight Marketing Circular No.07 of 2024 dated 23.02.2024, issued by Railway Board. Shri Murry intimated that Dimapur comes under Lumding Division of Railways and the matter is being pursued with Railway authorities. Shri Murry also intimated that SGST Nagaland has already nominated a Nodal Officer. The Chief Commissioner asked Commissioner, CGST

Commissionerate, Dimapur to appoint Nodal Officer in the grade of Additional/Joint Commissioner from Central GST side in terms of para-6 of Railway Board's Circular No.07 of 2024.

4. The Chief Commissioner desired to know whether GST authorities has been given access to the FOIS portal for detection of cases of evasion as deploying officers for manual round the clock checking is not worthy. The State GST Officials intimated that this access has not yet been given by Railway. It was intimated by the Additional Commissioner, CCO that this issue is being taken up with the GST Council Secretariat, by requesting them to pursue with Railway Board for allowing access to FOIS portal.

5. The next discussed was regarding the functioning of Biometric Aadhaar Authentication Centre for GST Registration (GSK). Shri Y. Mhathung Murry informed that Biometric Aadhar Authentication was implemented in the State of Nagaland w.e.f October 4, 2024 becoming the first State in the North East to do so. The State Taxes Department has opened a total of 9 GSKs covering the entire state. These GSKs are manned & managed by SGST officials of the state of Nagaland. It has received a total of 47 cases for Biometric Aadhaar Authentication. 34 cases have been successfully authenticated. 11 cases are pending due to expiry of date given for authentication, no response from the dealers and mismatch of PAN and Aadhaar data.

6. The Chief Commissioner desired to know the progress made by Dimapur Commissionerate regarding the directions given in the recent DO letter issued by him regarding welcoming the newly registered Taxpayers. The Commissioner, Dimapur Commissionerate intimated that he has already discussed this issue with the Division and it would be implemented. The Chief Commissioner stated that the Commissionerate should meet the Post Master General, Dimapur as per the advisory given in the DO letter. He further advised that the Commissionerate should also send greetings by post on important occasions like 26<sup>th</sup> January, 15<sup>th</sup> August etc. and if these are returned undelivered, the Commissionerate should take appropriate action to suspend such Registrations pending enquiry.

7. The Chief Commissioner then desired to know whether trainings on BO have been imparted to the CGST officers by State GST officials. Both the Central and State GST officials informed the meeting that such trainings have been conducted for all the officers.

8. The last issue discussed was regarding the present status of hiring office building for Circuit Bench of GSTAT at Kohima. The Commissioner, CGST Commissionerate, Dimapur intimated that a Building has been identified, which is presently under construction. He also intimated that the Commissionerate has written to CPWD for FRC, and the CPWD after visiting the said Building has

intimated that the process could be undertaken only after the construction is completed. The Chief Commissioner desired to know as to whether any office Building of BSNL is available for taking on rent. The Additional Commissioner, CGST Commissionerate, Dimapur informed that a 2000 Sq. Ft. Building is available but as per norms a Circuit Bench would require a space of 3670 Sq. Ft.

The Chief Commissioner informed the meeting that the Govt. has issued a Notification dated 26.12.2024 notifying jurisdiction of the State Bench and Circuit Benches. He also intimated that GSTAT is likely to start functioning from 01.01.2025 and hence the Commissionerate should pay special attention so that the process of hiring could be completed by December 2024.

13. To conclude, the Chief Commissioner thanked all the participants for attending the meeting.
