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Minutes of 1st & 2nd meeting of Nagaland State GST Co-ordination Committee for 2025-26 held on 25.09.2025.

The 1st & 2nd meeting (Qtr. ending June & September for the F.Y. 2025-26) of the Nagaland State Co-ordination Committee for F.Y. 2025-26 was held on 25.09.2025 at the Conference Hall, Room No.503, 5th Floor, GST Bhavan, Kedar Road, Guwhati in hybrid mode (both physical and virtual). The meeting was co-chaired by Dr. Shailendra Kumar Sinha, Chief Commissioner of CGST Guwahati Zone and Shri Abhinav Shivam, Commissioner of State Taxes, Nagaland. 2. The meeting commenced with the Chief Commissioner extending a warm welcome to all participants. He then sought an update on the action taken by both the Central and State authorities on the minutes of the previous meeting. He then asked the CGST, Dimapur officials to provide a status update on securing an office building for the tribunal. In response, the Additional Commissioner, CGST, Dimapur, informed that the financial sanction has been received from DoR. The Additional Commissioner, CGST Dimapur further intimated that interior design work is being prepared by the building owner. The Chief Commissioner urged the Commissioner, CGST to expedite the process especially since the GSTAT portal has been made operational w.e.f. 22.09.2025.

3. The Chief Commissioner then sought an update on the formation of FOIS committee proposed to be comprising 2 members from GST (1 member from each tax administration) and 2 members from Railway side for the purpose of discussing the relevant information (invoice of goods, e-way bill, details of consigner and consignee etc.) that the tax administrations actually require through FOIS and to explore the modalities of granting FOIS access to the Central and state GST tax administrations. In this regards, the Additional Commissioner, CGST intimated that the said committee is yet to be formed. The Chief Commissioner then directed the Additional Commissioner, CCO to send letters to CGST, State Taxes and Railways to nominate members for the said committee and directed that the said committee should be formed within 1st week of October.

4. The Chief Commissioner then suggested sharing alert Circulars between the State and central Tax administrations to curb fake registrations. The State as well as Central Tax administrations replied they already have the said such mechanism in place for sharing such circulars.

5. The Chief Commissioner suggested that both the Tax administrations should ensure issuance of the Welcome Kit to all new Registrants immediately after Registration is granted and then at regular intervals on occasions like Republic Day, Independence Day, and other important state holidays etc. and in case this comes back undelivered, the Registration can be suspended and then cancelled after observing due formalities.

6. The Chief Commissioner then desired to know the present status of establishment of Biometric Aadhaar Authentication Centre for GST Registration. The Additional Commissioner CGST, Dimapur intimated the CGST offices do not have Kiosk for Biometric Aadhaar Authentication for GST Registration. The Commissioner, State Taxes intimated that the state taxes offices have kiosks for Biometric Aadhaar Authentication for GST Registration.

7. The Chief Commissioner then asked about the status of GST FAQs to be disseminated in local languages. To which the Additional Commissioner, CGST intimated they are in the process of creating GST FAQs flyers/pamphlets using Comic book form.

8. The Chief Commissioner then sought an update on the proposed campaign in school and colleges against misuse of IDs for obtaining fake GST registrations. To which the Additional Commissioner, CGST Dimapur replied that they are planning to put flyers/pamphlets in schools spreading awareness about the said malpractice. He further intimated they are already in contact with Department of Education, Nagaland to initiate a

campaign in school and colleges cautioning against 'digital arrest' and they will use this to increase awareness about misuse of IDs.

9. The Chief Commissioner then sought an update on the awareness campaign about the ill use of drugs. To which the Additional Commissioner, CGST Dimapur replied that they are in the process of creating a short film/meme for educating the youth.

10. The Chief Commissioner then asked about the 'GST Sahyogi' program. The Additional replied that the training of 1st batch of 'GST Sahyogi' will be completed shortly.

11. To conclude, the Chief Commissioner thanked all the participants for attending the meeting.
