

DGGI finds ₹278-cr GST evasion in Rly purchases since July '17

The Directorate General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) has detected tax evasion worth ₹278 crore by bidders who were awarded Railway tenders since 2017. The probe by the investigation agency relates to instances of misclassification of rail supplies by winning bidders of



Railway tenders, the Parliament was informed. In March, *Business Standard* had reported that DGGI has initiated an investigation into tenders awarded by the Indian Railways since July 2017 after complaints were made by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs and the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade to the Ministry of Railways.
